"SHLICHIM" TO SPEAK AT ISRAEL INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

On Sunday, May 7, at 9:30 AM, Temple Beth Israel will celebrate "Yom Ha-Atzmaut" or Israel Independence Day at a bagel-and-lox breakfast provided by the Men's Club. While former celebrations featured a variety of individual, guest speakers, this celebration will feature two speakers, Meirav and Liron Cohen, an Israeli "shlichim" newlywed couple.



"Shlichim" are Israeli emissaries who represent the Community Shlichim program, which aims to provide educational programs to a broad audience of area children, teens and adults in various venues about Israeli history and culture and Jewish traditions. This program is sponsored locally by the Sarasota-Manatee Jewish Federation.

The couple's presentation will feature an introductory seven-minute film, a review of their work and their mission in this country, a description of what life is like for *sabras* in Israel, concluding with their concerns as ordinary Israeli citizens about Israel's future. An open question-and-answer period will follow. Both Liron, 26, and Miraiv, 26, born in Israel, graduated from Ben Gurion University of the Negev, Israel; and both serve in the Israeli military; he in the Israeli Air Force and she in the Israeli iOrdnance Corps.

The couple, married last year, are fluent in Hebrew and English and became "shlichim" in response to an advertisement by the Jewish Agency for Israel, which provided training sessions prior to their arrival here. They will later be traveling to other communities around the country.

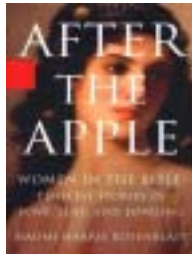

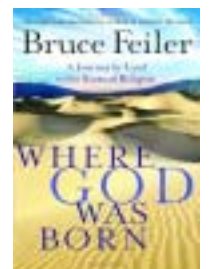

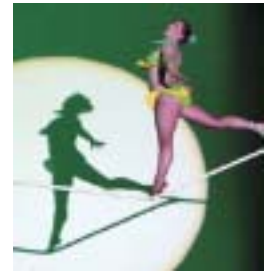

CIRCUS AERIALIST "FLIES HIGH" AT BIW

Internationally renowned circus performer, aerialist Dolly Jacobs, captivated her audience at the March 27 meeting of Beth Israel Women. Ms. Jacobs, accompanied by circus clown Chuck Sidlow, showed several videos, of herself performing her famous Roman Rings act, and her father, Lou Jacobs, in his signature act, sliding his 6 foot plus frame into a tiny car and generally clowning onstage. The latter was shown as a film clip from the movie "The Greatest Show on Earth" in which Lou. Jacobs was a featured performer.

Ms. Jacobs, a charming and natural speaker, entranced the audience of 30 plus people as she described her life as a circus enthusiast and the child of a world famous performer. Both Ms. Jacobs and her famous father have received numerous awards and have been recognized for their respective talents, specifically in the Circus Ring of Fame in St. Armand's Circle.



Mr. Sidlow described his entrance into the circus world via the Clown College, where he was mentored by Lou Jacobs. He showed his ability to fall down, but turned serious in discussing the work down by Laughter, Inc., an organization that brings lightheartedness to sick children and adults.

Circus Sarasota, where Ms. Jacobs is a featured performer, was founded by Ms. Jacobs and her husband, Pedro Reis. She is a co-producer of the circus and also is a volunteer advisor for the Sailor Circus.
